

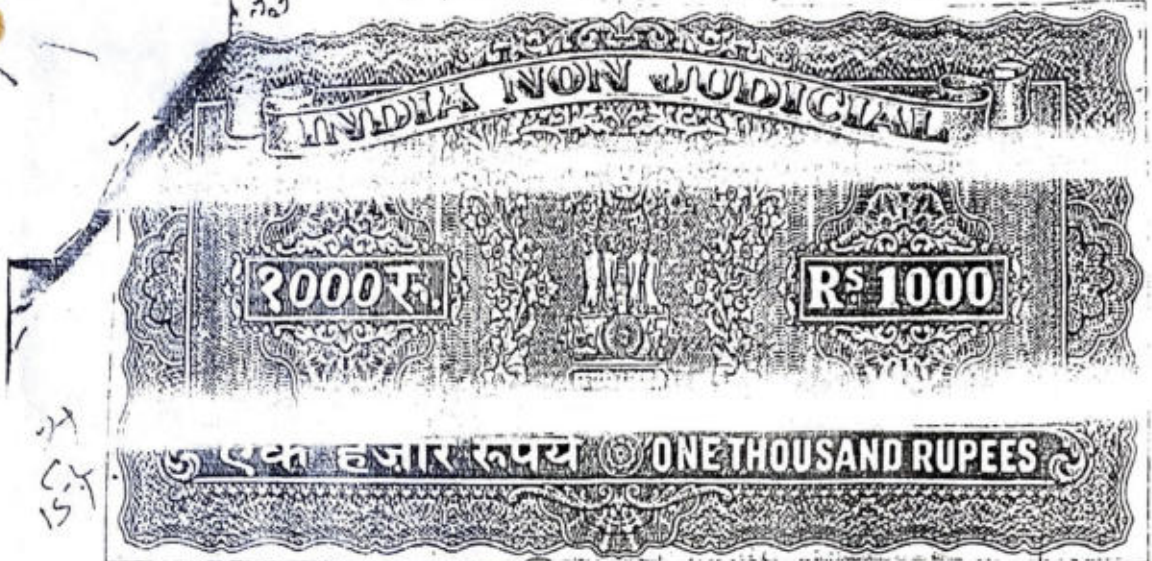

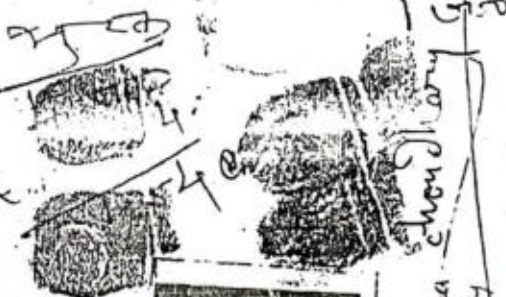

WHEREAS the settler is an Advocate and
great devotee of Lord Krishna and on the inspira-
tion and with the blessing of GURUDEO AND FATHER,
the settler is desirous of creating a trust in
their name and style of "SHREE RASH BIHARI MISSION"
and she decided to establish a fund for the furth-
erance of public charitable objects and for such
purpose within the meaning of the Income Tax Act, '61
as amended the settler has made over a sum of Rs. 11000/-
(Rupees Eleven thousand) only to the "Trustee" by way
of initial contribution.

AND WHEREAS the Trustees have agreed to become
trustees and to hold and apply the said sum of Rs.
11,000/- only and all donations and contributions

to the said fund for public charitable purposes
and subject to the Trust's powers and provisions
hereincontained in this deed.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS :-

1. The Trust shall be known as SHREE RASH BIHARI MISSION having its Head Office at R.B.S.R. Road, Khanjarpur, Bhagalpur and branch at Indradeo GURU Kripa Niwas Vrindaban in the state of U.P.
2. The Trustees hereby declare that they and the survivor or survivors of them or other Trustees hereof. for the time being will hold the said sum of Rs. 11,000/- (Rupees Eleven thousand) only made over by the settlor to the Trustees as aforesaid and all gifts, contributions, subscriptions, donations, bequests and other moneys or properties as and when the same shall be paid to or vested in them and the moneys

investments and properties from time to time representing the same upon Trust to apply the same for the relief of poor, Medical relief, education and the advancement of any other object of general public utility particularly for old and oldest and Orphan and helpless lady or for Charitable purpose which tends to promote international welfare in which India is interested provided however, no part of the fund or income thereof be applied to any purpose outside India except in accordance with the approval of the Central Board of Direct Taxes, Government of India and for such purpose (without restricting the generality of the foregoing objects) to do all or any of the following :-

- (I) To start an office for the Trust to organise a "Bridha Ashram" at Indradeo Guru Kripa Niwas Vrindaban (U.P) at any

other place in India to be decided by the Board of Trustee and to provide shelter to old, helpless and distitute Lady;

- a) to give shelter to those old, oldest, Orphan and helpless lady who have no where in the world and no base for their livelihood.
- b) to provide them a roof for their residence till their death;
- c) to provide them food, cloth, medicine;
- d) to provide them a platform for self earning ;
- e) to boostup religious+spiritual way by providing :
 - (i) to delivar religious SANSKAR,
 - (ii) to make arrangement for SANKIRTAN,
 - (iii) to make arrangement for religious discussions(SANGUSTHI);
 - (iv) to make arrangement for religious lectures(SATSANG + PRAVACHAN) ;

- (v) to arrange yearly and/or half-yearly special Religious festival ;
- (f) to make themselves self dependent;
- (g) to provide medical help to them ;
- (II) To assist, finance, support, establish and maintain any trust, society or institution meant for the relief of the poor, advancement of education, medical relief and / or advancement of any other object of general public utility.
- (III) To open, fund establish or finance, assist and contribute to the maintenance of hospitals and/or institutions for promotion of research and education in medical science including surgery.
- (IV) To open, fund establish and assist and maintain schools, colleges and boarding houses, and to promote and spread education in all

its branches and forms including Indian culture, heritage and scriptures by organising college Lecturers, talks, tours etc.

- (V) To open, fund establish or contribute to the maintenance of orphanages, widow homes, lunatic asylums, poor houses, etc.
- (VI) To provide stipends, scholarships and other aid for promoting studies, training or research,
- (VII) To establish, found and maintain libraries, reading rooms for convenience of the public.
- (VIII) To start, maintain and assist in relief measures in these areas which are or become subjected to natural calamities such as famine, epidemics, fire, flood, draught, earthquake, landslide, etc.
- (a) The settler/Trustee shall be managing trustee till her life and after her death her husband shall be managing trustee and after his death, two daughter of the settler shall be Managing Trustee, in yearly rotation

and thereafter in any case Managing Trustee will be among the family member of the settler.

- (B) The number of Trustees shall not be less than three and not more than seven, The trustees shall be Trustees for their life time but any trustee be resign by giving notice in writing to Managing trustees and shall also cease to be a Trustee if requested in writing by three-fourth of the remaining Trustees or the number nearest thereto.

Appointment of Trustees either to fill-up a vacancy or as additional trustee shall be by Managing Trustee.

4. The general management and control of the Trust for the purpose of Managing the trust affairs and properties (which includes any business undertaking) and carrying out the objects of the Trust aforesaid shall be vested in the Board of Trustee and controlled by Managing Trustee and without prejudice to the generality of the objects and purposes above mentioned Managing Trustee shall have power to do all or any of the following things

that is to say :-

- (a) To enter into contracts and borrow money for the purpose of the Trust and management of its properties and assets.
 - (b) To appoint Officers and servants at such remuneration (if any) as the Managing Trustee think fit and proper;
 - (c) To receive grants, donations and subscriptions and ~~ANNUAL RENTAL income from~~ Indradeo Guru Kripa Niwas and from Royalty and profit of book of the settler.
 - (d) To make rules and regulations from time to time for the management and conduct of the affairs of the Trust and its properties and assets.
5. The Managing Trustee will have the following powers :-
- a) To apply the whole or part of the income or accumulation thereof or whole or part of the purpose of the Trust, properties for one or more of the objects of the Trust as the Board of Trust may from time to time determine.
 - b. To amalgamate the trust with any other trust or society for wholly public charitable purposes.
 - c. To convert and get in the Trust properties and/or to vary the ~~investments~~ for the time being.

- d. To invest and keep invested the Trust Properties either in the purchase or mortgage of immovable properties or in shares, debentures, or other securities or by way of loans or deposits with the business undertaking and investments whether authorised by the Indian Trusts, Act, or not and to alter, vary or transpose such investments from time to time as the Managing Trustee shall in discretion think fit, provided however that such investments comply with the requirements of law for enjoying recognition and exemption from Income Tax.
- e. To sell, dispose of, eliminate or otherwise deal with any property moveable or immovable comprising the Trust Fund.
- f. To let out, demise any immovable property comprised in the Trust fund, for such period and at such rent on such terms and conditions as the Managing Trustee in their absolute discretion shall think fit.
- g. To open accounts with any Nationalised and/or scheduled Bank or Banks in the name of the Trust to operate such accounts and to give instructions to the Bank and to provide for opening and operation of such accounts by Managing Trustee or by one or more agents appointed by the Managing Trustee.
- h. To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to

- arbitration all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the trust properties or affairs,
1. To appoint constituted attorneys or agents and to delegate to such attorneys or agents all or any of the powers vested in them under these presents, and from time to time remove such attorneys or agent and to appoint other or others in his or their place.
 - j. e To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person (including all or any of the Trustees) as committee or Administrator or otherwise for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Board of Trust may decide.
 - k. To make vary alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out of the objects of the trust and for management of the affairs thereof and for running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the trust and otherwise for giving affect to the objects of the trust.
 1. To set apart the whole or part of the income of the corpus or part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.
 - 6.a. The Managing Trustees shall be chargeable only for such moneys, stocks shares and funds as shall actually come into their hands and shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect default acts of omission or commission of the other Trustees,

nor of any Bankers or other person with whom the Trust properties or any securities may have been deposited or handed over unless caused by their wilful neglect or default.

- b. The receipt of a person authorized by the Trustees or a resolution of the Board of Trustees for any moneys paid or any property transferred or delivered to the trustees in the execution of any of the trusts or powers hereof or for moneys of any property authorized to be said shall affectually discharge any person or persons so paying or transferring or delivering.

7. The Managing Trustee or member Trustee will not be entitled to receive any remuneration as Trustees but may reimburse themselves of all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the Trust or their duties relating thereto.

8. The Board of Trustees may from time to time frame rules for the conduct of the affairs of the Trust and regulating the meeting of Trustees. In the absence of such regulations :-

- 1) All matters will be decided by majority and two trustees including Managing Trustee shall form a Quorum for meeting of the Board of Trustees provided however if the number of Trustees falls below three than for purpose of appointing a Trustee one will be a Quorum.
- ii) Resolution passed without any meeting of Board of Trustees and evidenced in writing.

under the hands of Managing Trustee shall be as valid and effectual as a resolution duly passed at a meeting of the Board of trustees.

9. It is expressly declared that no part of the Trust property or its income shall be applied for any purpose which is not a public charitable purpose in law and nothing shall be construed to authorise the Trustees to utilise the trust assets or its income for any non-charitable purpose.

All the Powers and provisions hereof shall be construed as being subject to the restrictions and limitations herein contained.
